Designed exclusively for DNP's award-winning DS620A™, DS-RX1HS™, and DS820A™ dye-sublimation printers, the WPS Pro allows photographers to print directly from Wi-Fi enabled capture devices without the need for cables, memory cards, or an internet connection.

The WPS Pro is ideal for roaming photographers at event and party venues as well as amusement parks that require on-demand wireless printing workflows. It allows photographers to roam, capture, and instantly print candid shots wirelessly at theme parks, attractions, or amusements.

The WPS Pro will receive the images and automatically process, resize, and then print the images to the attached DNP photo printer. It can auto rotate the image to the correct landscape or portrait orientation. It can also add a custom banner border or decorative frame to the images automatically during image processing.

The WPS Pro features an easy-to-read 6.8" touchscreen display that allows users to easily monitor print jobs, printer status, and see prints remaining count. The touchscreen also makes it easy to configure changes including language, default print queues, and applying graphic borders.

For additional control, DNP's Mobile Status App provides simple control of the WPS Pro and a convenient printer and server control interface that allows operators to see near-real-time feedback on printer status, configuration control and job process status. In addition, DNP's WPS Print 2 App allows users to wirelessly print directly from a mobile device to a connected DNP printer. The Mobile Status and WPS Print 2 Apps are available as free downloads for iOS and Android devices from their respective marketplaces

Using its built-in 802.11 b/g/n Wi-Fi, the WPS Pro creates its own dedicated Wi-Fi access point that allows users to print from DSLR cameras with a Wi-Fi adapter, mobile devices (including phones and tablets), as well as Windows or Mac computers, all without the need for an Internet connection or Wi-Fi infrastructure. WPS Pro supports up to five simultaneous wireless device connections.

With its own network access point, no router is required to print via the WPS Pro allowing for increased flexibility in workflow, set design, and hardware arrangement. A single WPS Pro can connect with two DNP photo printer models for speed/redundancy or for an increased range of print size options. The device allows for dozens of print sizes including the most popular 2x6" photo strips, 5x5" and 6x6" square prints as well as traditional 4x6", 5x7", 6x8", 8x10" and 8x12 sizes, depending on the printer combination and print media that's loaded. It also supports printing with glossy, matte, fine matte, and luster finishes; and can be configured to combine images with custom graphic borders.
