

With the use of a Bluetooth dongle such as the Planex, BT-MicrtoEDR2X, the SL10[™] SnapLab® will accept images from Bluetooth compatible phones etc.

To enable Bluetooth on the SL10

1. The unit must be at firmware version 1.01. This firmware update is available at:

2. Insert a USB Bluetooth dongle into the USB-A port in the rear of the SL10.



Example: Planex model BT-MicroEDR2X (sold separately).

3. The SL10 must have an expansion Compact Flash card with the standard SL10 folders.
