DNP Showcases Wireless Print Server and Apps at Imaging USA 2016

Increasing Mobile Device Support for Its Leading Line of Dye-sublimation Photo Printers

ATLANTA, Georgia – At ImagingUSA 2016, DNP Imagingcomm America Corporation (DNP IAM) will be showcasing its new WPS-1 Wireless Print Server mobile photography solution. Designed exclusively for DNP's award-winning DS40™, DS80™, RX1™, and DS620A™ dye-sublimation printers, the WPS-1 allows photographers to print directly from Wi-Fi enabled capture devices as well as a wide variety of third party solutions, including CamRanger™, Simple Booth™, and WiPics.

Ideal for on-site or mobile printing solutions that need wireless printing workflows, the WPS-1 is a set-top box running custom DNP software that replaces a typical PC and network router. Using its built-in 802.11 b/g/n Wi-Fi access point, the WPS-1 allows users to print from Wi-Fi enabled DSLR cameras, iOS phones, Android phones, and Android-based cameras, as well as printing from Windows or Mac computers, all without the need for an internet connection. It also allows users to select and print groups of photos using tablets running iOS, Android, or Windows. The WPS-1 supports up to five simultaneous wireless device connections.

"Mobile, wireless tools are an increasingly important part of our customers' workflow," said Katsuyuki Oshima, President of DNP Imagingcomm America Corporation. "The WPS-1 and companion WPS Status and WPS Print 2 apps support this trend and will expand the functionality of our printers for a variety of applications, providing new opportunities for our customers to upgrade their services."

A single WPS-1 can connect to two identical DNP photo printer models for redundancy or connect to two different models for an increased range of print size options. The device allows for multiple print sizes including popular 2"x6" photo strips, 5"x5" and 6"x6" square prints, and many more standard sizes—4"x6" up to 8"x12"—depending on the combination of printers and media. It also supports printing with glossy and matte finishes and can be configured to combine images with custom borders.

DNP's new mobile apps also provide simple control and feedback from mobile devices. The WPS Print 2 app includes shoot-and-print camera function, the ability to print from gallery/camera roll as well as new features including print size and image print quantity selections. In addition, WPS Print 2 provides the ability to print from other apps using the share/share sheet functionality.

DNP's WPS Status app is designed to provide a convenient window to the printer and print server status that allows operators to see near real-time feedback on printer and job printing status. Low-paper warnings and other errors can also be seen on mobile devices via the app.

The WPS Print 2 and WPS Status apps are available as a free download for iOS and Android devices from their respective marketplaces.
