



DS Printers (DS40/DS80/RX1) Enabling 2-Inch Cuts on Mac



Overview

The 2-inch cut feature on the DS40 and RX1 will cut a 4x6 print into two 2x6 prints. This is typically used in photobooth applications. Enabling 2 inch cuts on a Mac requires the use of CUPS, or *Common UNIX Printer Service*. CUPS is a web-based application that simplifies printer management interface. CUPS is part of OS X.

Enabling CUPS

1. Open Terminal.
 - a. Click **Go** on the **Finder** menu.
 - b. Click **Utilities**.
 - c. Select **Terminal**.




2. Type the following: `cupsctl WebInterface=yes`
3. Press **ENTER**.

```


4. Close **Terminal** by clicking the red **Close** button in the upper left on the title bar.

Enabling 2 Inch Cuts

1. Open **Safari**.
2. Type <http://127.0.0.1:631/printers> to open CUPS. The list of current installed printers will be displayed.
3. Click on the **DSRX1**.
4. Click the drop-down menu for **Administration** and select **Set Default Options**.



5. Switch to the **General** menu.
6. Select the correct paper size by clicking the drop-down for the **Media Size** option and clicking on either **6x4** or **6x8**. The 6x4 size will cut two 6x2 strips. The 6x8 size will cut four 6x2 strips.
7. Click the drop-down menu for the **Cutter** option at the bottom of the list.
8. Select **2-Inch Cut**.
9. Click the **Set Default Options** button at the bottom of the screen to save the selected options.
10. Enter the login information for the computer when prompted.
