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1 Starting the Administrative application

Press the logo in the upper left of the standby screen or input method selection screen for 3 sec. or more.

Alternatively, press the shortcut key (Ctrl+A).


Enter the password, and press the [OK] button.

Administrator user's initial password (default):

"9999"

You can also use general user's password and it will be configured in password settings tab in administrative application.



When the administrative application is started from the Start menu, the screen shown on the left will appear.

Enter the same password as shown in 1-3, and press the [Login] button.

1-5



- Authority
 Shows the authority of the user who has logged in.
- (2) Date and time

 Shows the current date and time.
- (3) Terminal ID Shows the corresponding terminal ID.
- (4) On-screen keyboard Starts the on-screen keyboard.



- (5) Explorer [Shown only when logged on Administrator account] Start Windows Explorer.
- (6) Reboot
 Reboot the terminal
- (7) Shutdown Shut down the terminal.

- (8) Close [Shown only when logged on Administrator account] Close admin application and show desktop.
- (9) Launch Main Application

Exits the administrative application, and starts the application from which you open the administrative application.


For instance, if you open the administrative application from the store menu in launcher, launcher application will be started again. While you open the administrative application from the store menu in NX Plus⁺, NX Plus⁺ will be started again.

The following describes the functions available from the Maintenance screen.


2 Maintenance Functions

2-1 Hardware Check

You can check the status of all hardware connected to your machine.



(1) Printer: Advanced: [Advanced]
Select this button to show the detailed information of the selected printer.



Press the [Advanced] button to open the Printer Details dialog window, showing the detailed information of the corresponding printer.

(2) Printer: Test Print: [Test Print]
Select this button to start test print on the corresponding printer.

(3) Receipt Printer: Test Print: [Test Print]
Select this button to start test print of the receipt specified in the list shown on the left.

(4) Drive: [LED Check] Select this button to show the connection status of the card reader and CD drive. In addition, the LED lamp test is also performed. This is performed only when you use NX Plus⁺ on DNP order terminal DS-T3r.


2-2 Report

2 - 2 - 1 Sales Report

You can check the sales information for the specified period and perform receipt print of the sales information.

Daily Report

Used for display and receipt print of the sales information collected for each day.



(1) Search: Service

Specify the service to narrow down the search.

(2) Search: Print Size

Specify the print size to narrow down the search.

(3) Search: Year

Specify the year of the date to narrow down the search.

(4) Search: Month

Specify the month of the date to narrow down the search.

(5) Search: [Search]

Select this button to start searching the sales information based on the search conditions set in (1) to (4) and show the search result in the Sales Report field.

(6) Sales Report

Shows a list of sales information found based on the specified search conditions.

Press a line to select it. Press again to deselect the line.


(7) [Receipt Print]

format.

Select this button to print the sales information of the selected line in receipt format. If no line is selected, all sales information shown in the Sales Report field is printed in receipt

Monthly Report

Used for display and receipt print of the sales information collected for each month.



(1) Search: Service

Specify the service to narrow down the search.

(2) Search: Print Size

Specify the print size to narrow down the search.

(3) Search: Year

Specify the year of the date to narrow down the search.

(4) Search: [Search]

Select this button to start searching the sales information based on the search conditions set in (1) to (3) and show the search result in the Sales Report field.

(5) Service Report

Shows a list of sales information found based on the specified search conditions.

Press a line to select it. Press again to deselect the line.


(6) [Receipt Print]

Select this button to print the sales information of the selected line in receipt format.

If no line is selected, all sales information shown in the Service Report field is printed in receipt format.

Sales Report

Used for display and receipt print of a sales information list.



(1) Search: Beginning

Specify the information collection start date and time to narrow down the search.

(2) Search: End

Specify the information collection end date and time to narrow down the search.

(3) Search: [Search]

Select this button to start searching the sales information based on the search conditions specified in (1) and (2) and show the search result in the Sales Report field.

(4) Sales Report

Shows a list of sales information found based on the specified search conditions.

Press a line to select it. Press again to deselect the line.

(5) [Receipt Print]


Select this button to print the sales information of the selected line in receipt format. If no line is selected, all sales information shown in the Sales Report field is printed in receipt format.

[Output Files]

Select this button to output the currently displayed sales information to a file.

Report Per Order

Used for list display and receipt re-print of sales information for each order.



(1) Search: Search by Date: Year, Month, Day

Specify the year, month, and day to narrow down the search.

(2) Search: Search by Date: [Previous Day]

Select this button to decrement the date set in (1).

(3) Search: Search by Date: [Next Day]

Select this button to increment the date set in (1).

(4) Search: Search by Date: [Search by Date]

Select this button to start searching the sales information based on the specified date (year, month, and day) and show the search result in the Sales Report field.

(5) Order Number: Order Number

Specify the order number to search.

(6) Order Number: [Search by Order Number]

Select this button to search the sales information based on the order number specified in (5) and show the search result in the Sales Report field.

(7) Sales Report

Shows a list of sales information found based on the specified search conditions.

Press a line to select it. Press again to deselect the line.

(8) [Re-print Network Receipt]

Select this button to re-prints the information on the selected line in receipt format.


This button is available only if the selected line is assigned to PrintTurbine.

(9) [Re-print Receipt]

Select this button to re-print the information on the selected line in receipt format.

2 - 2 - 2 Operation Report

You can check the operation information for the specified period.



(1) Search: Start

Specify the search start date to narrow down the search.

(2) Search: End

Specify the search end date to narrow down the search.

(3) Search: Category

Specify the category to narrow down the search.

(4) Page change buttons

Allow for changing the page of the Operation Report list.

[First]: Displays the first page.


[<] : Displays the previous page.

[>] : Displays the next page.

[Last] : Displays the last page.

2-3 Payment

You can set the unit price, optional price, and tax rate for each service.



Setting the unit price (plain paper)


- Free Mode: [Free Mode (1 time)]
 Select this button to set the unit price to be free next order only.
- (2) Tax rate (General)

 Set the tax rate and whether to show the tax-inclusive or tax-exclusive price.
- (3) Unit Price: Search
 Specify the service and print size for which you will set the unit price.
 - If you change the service or print size, the content of the Unit Price Setting field is switched accordingly.
- (4) Unit Price Setting

Set the unit price for the service and print size specified in (3).

- * For the unit price, maximum five types can be set for each combination of Service and Print Size. When setting multiple unit prices, specify the range of sheets to which the unit price is applied in the Print Quantity column.
- (5) [Save]

Setting the optional price



(1) Unit Price: Search

Specify the service and print size for which you will set the optional price. If you change the service or print size, the content of the Unit Price Setting field is switched accordingly.


- (2) Unit Price Setting

 Set the unit price for the service and print size specified in (1).
- (3) [Save]
 Select this button to save the changes made on this screen.

2-4 Service

2-4-1 Main Menu

You can set the services used in the main application and their display positions on the menu screen.




(1) Main Items

Set the services which you want to display in a large size in the upper portion of the Main Menu screen of the main application.

- (2) Sub Items
 - Set the services which you want to display in a small size in the lower portion of the Main Menu screen of the main application.
- (3) [Save]
 - Select this button to save the changes made on this screen.
- * Services which are not set in either Main Items or Sub Items will be disabled in the main application.

2-4-2 Store Menu

You can set the functions used on the Store Menu screen of the main application and their display positions on the screen.



(1) Store Menu item

Set and locate the menu items displayed on the Store Menu screen of the main application.

The set menu items are located as follows:

Service set in 1 appears in the upper left of the Store Menu screen.

Service set in 2 appears in the upper right of the Store Menu screen.

Service set in 3 appears in the central left of the Store Menu screen.

Service set in 4 appears in the central right of the Store Menu screen.

Service set in 5 appears in the lower left of the Store Menu screen.

Service set in 6 appears in the lower right of the Store Menu screen.

(2) Path

Set the path to the ID photo or external application execution file.

This setting is available only if ID Photo or external application is set in (1).

(3) Title

Set the title of the external application displayed in the main application.

This setting is available only if external application is set in (1).

(4) Icon

Set the icon of the ID photo or external application displayed in the main application.

This setting is available only if ID Photo or external application is set in (1).


(5) [Save]

Select this button to save the changes made on this screen.

* Functions which are not set on this screen will be unavailable from the main application.

2-5 Print Size

You can set the print size used for each service.




- (1) Search
 - Select the service for which you want to set the print size.
- (2) Print Size
 - Select the print size used for the service specified in (1).
 - * For Type-LE, the 6x9, 8x10 and 8x12 size is not displayed.
- (3) [Save]
 - Select this button to save the changes made on this screen.

2-6 Hardware

2-6-1 Printer

You can make printer settings, printer color adjustment, and output settings for each paper type.



(1) Printer Configuration: Printer

Select the printers used in the main application.

(2) Printer Configuration: Paper Type

Select the type of paper loaded in the printer.

(3) Printer Configuration: Advanced [Advanced]

Select this button to show the detailed information of the selected printer.



Press the [Advanced] button to open the Printer Details dialog window, showing the detailed information of the corresponding printer.

You can make the color adjustment for the printer.

(4) Printer Configuration: [Update Printers]

Select this button to perform re-detection of the currently set printers.

(5) Multi Printer Control

Select the print control method of the main application.

[Priority on print speed]: Performs printing as quick as system possible.

[Priority on printing in order]: Performs printing in order of displayed images.

(6) Limit the order as to the remaining media

Set whether or not to control the number of ordered prints to be accepted according to the remaining quantity of the loaded paper.

[Limited]: Does not accept an order of printing which exceeds the remaining quantity of the loaded paper.

[Unlimited]: Accepts an order of printing which exceeds the remaining quantity of the loaded paper.

(7) Output Device: Output Printer

Set the printer to be used for each paper size shown on the left.

(8) Output Device: Output Media

Set the actual paper size on which printing is performed for each paper size shown on the left.

(9) Output Device: Matte

Set whether or not to apply a matte finish for each paper size.


(10) [Save]

2-6-2 Receipt Printer

You can make receipt printer settings, format customization of voucher and receipt, and specify whether or not to print voucher.

[Voucher] tab

Customizing the voucher format and setting whether or not to print voucher



(1) Receipt Printer

Select the receipt printer to be used.

(2) Receipt Configuration: Receipt Printer

Set whether or not to print voucher and receipt in the main application.

[OFF]: Prints no voucher.
[Voucher]: Prints voucher.

[Voucher & Receipt]: Prints voucher and receipt in this order.

(3) Receipt Printer: Paper Width (mm)

Set the format of voucher printed in the main application.

Set the paper width for the receipt printer selected in (1).

(4) Receipt Configuration: Format

Set the format of voucher printed in the main application.





Select the receipt printer to be used.

(2) Receipt Configuration: Network Receipt Printer

Set whether or not to print receipt in the main application.

[OFF]: Prints no receipt.

[Voucher]: Prints receipt.

(3) Receipt Printer: Paper Width (mm)

Set the format of receipt printed in the main application.

Set the paper width for the receipt printer selected in (1).

(4) Receipt Configuration: Format

Set the format of receipt printed in the main application.

(5) Receipt Configuration: [Update]

Select this button to reflect the receipt format and paper width set above in the review.







Set the default order sorting of image file in the main application.

(2) [Prior Filtering]


Set whether to enable or disable prior filtering before loading images on main application. Show-Enable filtering *If value is set to "0", this function is disabled.

Hide-Disable filtering

(3) [Save]

2-8 Language Settings

You can set the default language, whether or not to enable language changing, and the national flag corresponding to the specified language.




(1) Language Settings: Default

Select the [Default] button to set the corresponding language to be used as the default. The default language will be reflected in the default language of the main application, the language of the administrative application, receipt, and price indication. Currency used in main application is also defined regarding to this setting.

- (2) Language Settings: Language
 Select the selectable language in the main application.
- (3) Language Settings: Country/Region The specified language will be set.
- (4) Language Settings: Flag Set the national flag image to be displayed on the language selection screen of the main application.
- (5) [Save]
 Select this button to save the changes made on this screen.

2-9 Password Settings

You can set the password of the user who will use the administrative application.



(1) Change Password: Account Name

Select the administration authority of the user for whom you want to change the password.



(2) Change Password: Old Password Shows the currently used password.



2-10 Update

You can update the system.



- System Update: Read from
 Specify the folder in which the system update program is stored.
- (2) System Update: [Auto Retrieving] Select this button to search for the update program on media cards and CD-ROM. If multiple updates exist, the Update System window appears.




(3) System Update: [Update] Select this button to start the update program to update the system files.

2-11 Log

2-11-1 Search Log

You can operate log files.



(1) Log: [Clear Log]

Select this button to clear the log files in the log folder.

(2) Log: [Export Log (All)]

Select this button to open the Select Folder dialog window, prompting you to select the folder to which the log files will be output.

Upon folder selection, all the log files are output to the selected folder.

(3) Log: [Export Log (7 days)]

Select this button to open the Select Folder dialog window, prompting you to select the folder to which the log files will be output.


Upon folder selection, the log files for the last seven days are output to the selected folder.

(4) Log: [Reset Order number]

Select this button to initialize the order numbers in the main application.

2-12 User Account Authority

You can set the user account authority.



(1) Account

Select the user for whom you want to change the access permission.

(2) Access Permission


This field allows you to set the selected screen to [Inaccessible], [Read Only], or [Full Access].

(3) [Save]

2-13 Internal Settings

2-1 3-1 Input Device

You can set the image input devices.



(1) Input Device: Drive

Select the drives from which images are inputted by the main application.

DO NOT select local drive or network drive. Please select only removable media drive.

(2) Drive Check: Drive

Select the drives of which connection is checked by the main application.

Connection check is done when the main application is started. If this check failed at that time,

You can not use main application until this check is completed correctly.

(3) Drive Check: [Auto Detect]


Select this button to set the currently connected drives to the selected state.

This button will also detect the local and network drive (i.e. C:\) on your computer. Please check them off by yourself. Otherwise the main application will detect your system drive as an input media.

(4) [Save]

2-1 3-2 Reading Restriction

You can set the image input limits.



(1) Minimum size [Pixel]

Set the minimum image size [Pixel] for orders.

If any one side of the image input by the main application is smaller than the minimum size, no order can be placed.

(2) Resized size [Pixel]

Set the internal reduction size [Pixel].

If any one side of the input image exceeds the specified reduction size during image input by the main application, both vertical and horizontal lengths of the image are reduced.

(3) Maximum size [Pixel]

Set the maximum image size [Pixel] for orders.

If any one side of the image input by the main application exceeds the maximum size, no order can be placed.

(4) Maximum file size [MB]

Set the maximum file size [MB] for orders.

If the size of the image file input by the main application exceeds the maximum size, no order can be placed.

(5) Accepted Images Number

Set the maximum number of images that can be input by the main application.

(6) Warned Size [Pixel]

Set the image size subject to warning.


If any one side of the image input by the main application is smaller than the size, the warning icon appears.

* For Type-LE, A5W, 8x10 and 8x12 are not displayed.

(7) [Save]

2-13-3 System Settings (1)

You can set the date and time, computer name, terminal information, scheduled reboot, scheduled shutdown, configuration export/import, and initialization.



(1) Date and Time

Set the current date and time.

(2) Computer Name

Set the computer name.

(3) Terminal

Set the terminal ID.

(4) Reboot at the stated time

Set whether to enable or disable scheduled reboot.

If you choose [Enable], specify the day of the week and the time (hours and minutes) for starting the system reboot.

(5) Shutdown at the stated time

Set whether to enable or disable scheduled shutdown.

If you choose [Enable], specify the day of the week and the time (hours and minutes) for starting the system shutdown.

(6) Export

[Export Settings]: Opens the Browse Folder dialog window to prompt you to export the configuration file. Exported file is named as the rule below.

"terminal ID" _ "date"

If no terminal ID is defined, file name above will start from the date.

[Import Settings]: Opens the Browse Folder dialog window to prompt you to import the configuration file. Exported has some sub folders in it. Please select parent folder here to complete this process.

(7) Initialization


Select the [Factory preset settings] button to perform the initialization.

- Configuration file initialization
- Log file deletion

(8) [Save]

2-13-4 System Settings (2)

You can make the settings for the operation mode, card reader, screen timeout, maximum order quantity, and remaining media quantity offset.



(1) Operation Mode

Set the operation mode of the main application.

[Normal]: Normal operation mode.

[Free (with fee indicter)] This button is not used in this version.

[Demo]: Operation with no printer connected.

(2) Card Reader: [Light LED in standby screen]

Select this button to enable LED lighting on the standby screen of the main application.

Deselected if the card reader is general-purpose type.

(3) Card reader name

Select the card reader to be used.

YD-8V74···If you use 8V74 media reader, please select this. This allows you to use LED light on the media reader and get a detailed log files.

Generic Media reader...If your media reader is not 8V74, please select this.

LC-1 \cdots This is not used at this version.

(4) Ribbon near end detection

Set the remaining ribbon count near the end.

If the remaining quantity of paper loaded in the printer connected by the main application is less than the remaining ribbon count near the end, the currently displayed printer icon turns from blue to green.

(5) Timeout [Sec]

Set the time of screen timeout.

(6) Maximum quantity per orderSet the maximum quantity per order.

(7) Offset For Remaining Media Count


Set the offset value for the quantity of the paper loaded in the printer.

Please **Do not** change this value in normal use.

(8) [Save]

2-13-5 Function Settings

You can make the settings for the screen saver, edit screen, printing screen, print confirmation screen, automatic color adjustment, drawing, receipt printing, and additional orders.



(1) Screen Saver

Set whether to show or hide the screen saver of the main application.

- (2) Edit Screen: Color Adjustment (ON/OFF)

 Set whether or not to enable brightness and color balance adjustment on the edit screen of the main application.
- (3) Edit Screen: Exif Data
 Set whether to show or hide Exif data on the edit screen of the main application.
- (4) Edit Screen: Fit Image

 Set whether to show or hide [Fit image] button on edit screen of the main application.

 [Fit Image] enables you to put whole image on the sheet with white margin.
- (5) Edit Screen: Add Text
 Set whether to show or hide [Text] button on edit screen of the main application.
 - * For Type-LE, This function does not appear.

(6) Edit Screen: Color Setting

Show Color setting window.

* For Type-LE, This function does not appear.



- a) Color box-Selected colors here appear on text edit screen. The one at the left top is set to default.
- b) Selected color box-When you select the color from color box above, it is shown here. Color is able to be changed changing RGB value.
- c) Apply changes to color box.
- (7) Printing Screen: Slide Show

Set whether to enable or disable the slide show on the printing screen of the main application.

(8) Error Screen: Media Size Change Notice

Set whether to enable or disable the notice when print media is replaced with different size.

(9) Error Screen: Admin Button

Set whether to show [Admin] button on error screen.

(10) Print Confirmation Screen

Set whether to show or hide the print confirmation screen of the main application.

(11) Print Password

Set whether to require the password before printing or not.

(12) Auto Color Adjustment: Enable for these services

Select the service for which Auto Color Adjustment will be used.

* For Type-LE, no change can be made.

(13) Auto Color Adjustment: Module

Select the module for which Auto Color Adjustment will be used.

* For Type-LE, no change can be made.

(14) Decoration: Services

Select the service in which the drawing screen of the main application will be used.

(15) Decoration: Tools

Select the drawing tools to be used in the main application.

* For Type-LE, [Stamp] and [Rolling Stamp] are not displayed.

(16) Decoration: Border Edit

Start border edit application.

(17) Receipt Printing

Specify whether or not to print receipt in the main application.

(18) Additional Order

Set whether to enable or disable additional order and index additional order on the order

confirmation screen of the main application.

* For Type-LE, no setting is available.

(19) Separator (Local)


Set whether to enable or disable separator print from local printer.

(20) [Save]

2-14 PrintTurbine Settings


* For Type-LE, this screen is not displayed. You need to configure this setting only when you have PrintTurbine products.

PrintTurbine is a server application which allows you to create print server system in local network using NX Plus⁺/ IDX as client application. Please ask your sales agent.



2-15 Launcher Settings

You can make the launcher application settings.



(1) Launcher

Set whether to enable or disable the launcher application.

(2) Flash Setting

Set whether to show or hide the standby screen of the launcher application.

(3) Flash Setting: Flash

Set the path to the Flash animation displayed on the standby screen of the launcher application.

(4) Application: Name1...

Set the application name to be displayed as the setting item in the Screen Layout field shown below.

(5) Application: Icon

Set the icon to be displayed for the corresponding application.

(6) Application: Application 1 ···

Set the path to the selected application started by the launcher application.

*NX Plus⁺ has been already set in Application 1.

(7) Screen Layout

Set and locate the items displayed in the menu by the launcher application.

Service set in 1 appears in the upper left of the menu screen.

Service set in 2 appears in the upper center of the menu screen.


Service set in 3 appears in the upper right of the menu screen.

The layout is automatically adjusted to center the icon. For instance, if a service is set in 1 and this is the only service set here, the icon for it will be located in the center of screen.






